The PTO will look into these issues and seek to improve them.


Some actions – like moving Summer Fayre to Spring – would need school approval and be planned for the next school year due to the calendar process.

How Can We Improve Our Communication? (1)

- Provide a satisfaction survey after each event
- Mass communications over so many year groups are not good for all items
- More incentive for kids to volunteer and earlier communication to school
- I found that the PTO links in emails frequently didn't work, so fixing that would be an improvement.
- WhatsApp group is more convenient
- Maybe the pto staff can go to the classes and introduce each one and tell to the students which is the role that you have
- I think your communication is very clear.






How Can We Improve Our Communication?(2)

Which events have you attended?




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For which events have you volunteered?

- No prior communication on the need for tickets and activities.










Comments & suggestions for Summer Fayre (1)


Comments & suggestions for Summer Fayre (2)

Comments & suggestions for Summer Fayre (3)

Comments & suggestions for Summer Fayre (4)



• The amount of inflatables offered was tremendous, you could tell the kids loved them. There were however obvious staffing / supervising issues at the beginning. Given that the event was clearly advertised as providing saftey people to supervise, as opposed to parents being fully responsible, this was poor. There was also a water issue that delayed opening half the inflatables, it needed to be turned on by the school. The gentlemen from the inflatable company had only the main school number which was going to voice mail. Perhaps he could have been given a cell number for one of the key organizers so that any issues like that could have been flagged guickly & dealt with. The ice cream stand was a great idea, I am sure it went down well given the heat. The DJ providing the music was a fun touch but the volume was off the charts! Like ear bleeding loud. Was it due to the location, sound being held in because the speakers were under the covered area? I did have two comments made to me, separately, on the music being too loud. I do also think the pricing of the concessions, sold by the PTO, needs to be looked at. I feel they are a bit too high. Almost to the point it feels a bit mercenary. I understand the desire to make a profit but surely not at the expense of having parents feel ripped off. I do believe the event was enjoyed by all that attended and these large events are always a challenge to staff with volunteers. I do believe very strongly however that if it is apparent that there are not going to be enough adult bodies to create a safe environment (volunteers sign up in advance so numbers can be checked prior to the event running) and it can not be remedied then adjustments to what is available, in this case inflatables needs to be made. I appreciate the change of date may also have impacted volunteer numbers.



Comments & suggestions for International Day(1)




- I wish that school will encourage the students participate in the event, not only in the final assembly at the end of the event.

Comments & suggestions for Future Fund (2)




- Great concept. Always difficult to get all parents to contribute. Would be great to get more parents onboard to keep it fair

Have you bought anything from the shop?




- Child is year 12 so not needed

Rate your satisfaction with the range of payment options offered by the PTO.1 (Poor) 2 3 4 5 (Great!) Average is 4.6








Did you know about the PTO's passive sources of income?
